



Safety Assessment for Research Spaces

Clients intending to apply for research spaces associated with laboratory operations at the Science Park are required to provide all relevant information via the Business Information for Suitability Assessment (BISA) online system. For occasions when clients are not applying via the BISA online system, they are still required to complete the form “Safety Assessment for Research Spaces” (available on the website of SHE Office) and send it together with other necessary information to SHE Office for safety assessment and approval.

SHE Office carries out assessment for each application taking the followings into consideration:

1. If the hazardous substances or laboratory operations involved pose significant health, safety and environmental risk to the laboratory personnel and the premises;
2. If the use of hazardous substances or equipment complies with local legislations or HKSTP’s safety guidelines;
3. If sufficient control measures will be in place; and
4. If appropriate emergency response plan is available.

Upon completion of assessment and granting of approval, clients shall renovate or fit out the assigned laboratory spaces in accordance with HKSTP Laboratory Design Guidelines.
