

Vehicles and Carpark Environmental Management

Use of Vehicles

- ✓ Use legal fuel
- ✓ All vehicles should be maintained regularly
- ✓ Switch off the vehicle engine when stationary
- ✓ wastewater generated from vehicle washing shall be discharged to a foul sewer
- ✓ take the shortest route to the designated destination
- ✓ Avoid unnecessary acceleration and deceleration, because it increases fuel consumption
- ✓ Close windows when travelling at high speed – this will decrease aerodynamic drag and lower fuel consumption.
- ✓ Avoid carrying unnecessarily things or installing unnecessary car fittings as extra weight will result in fuel wastage and extra pollution.
- ✓ Only use air-conditioning when you have to – flow-through ventilation or open windows at lower speeds can be just as effective without the extra fuel consumption.

Maintenance of vehicles

- ✓ Ensure checking and maintenance of vehicles is by qualified personnel and planned schedule
- ✓ Maintain correct tyre pressure by inspecting your tyres regular and inflating them to the pressure recommended by the manufacturer
- ✓ Ensure proper procedures are being followed during maintenance of air-containing system and disposal of refrigerants.
- ✓ Instruct staff not to discharge any chemicals in any drains directly.
